

Coordinated Audit on Preparation of the National Governments of Latin America to implement the Sustainable Development Objectives

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

NATIONAL ANALYSIS OF PERU

Government Center

According with the revision of the Supreme Audit Institution of Peru (SAI Peru), the agenda will be incorporated in the actualization of the Strategic Plan for National Development (PEDN) towards 2030. The PEDN is looking to articulate policies and plans along the 3 government's levels.

This task is leaded by the National Center for Strategic Planning (CEPLAN) within the framework of the National Strategic Planning System (SINAPLAN) looking to facilitate the articulation, coordination, monitoring and evaluation of the policies regarding SDGs. The National Institute of Statistics and Informatics (INEI) developed a SDG monitoring and follow-up system. Our SAI detected the weakness of the agenda internalization process, as SDG and their goals are in a process of adaptation. Furthermore, there is still an ongoing formulation of the national indicators, the alignment with the policies associated with the SDG has not been concluded, and the transversal, transparency and participation coordination mechanisms are in development.

Implementation of the Goal 2.4

According to SAI Peru's report, the agenda sectorial internalization is weak, as the Ministry of Agriculture and Irrigation (MINAGRI) has not officially specified the objectives his agrarian national policy contributing to the achievement of goal 2.4. There are areas for improvement in the alignment of regulatory frameworks and sectorial public policies (e.g. land use for agricultural and territorial regulation purposes), in order to avoid overlapping, duplication and gaps. On the other hand, even though this Ministry has coordination mechanisms, these are not yet orientated to the implementation of Goal 2.4. MINAGRI has a follow-up and evaluation system for the main interventions in the agrarian sector; however they have not developed a specific mechanism to perform the follow-up and evaluation to the achievement of goal 2.4. In addition, there is a weak

articulation process among the 3 government levels regarding agricultural sector policies (and other sectors) related to goal 2.4.

Highlights

A good practice is Peru's coordinated construction vision towards 2030. This began with a future image proposal, linked to the 2030 Agenda based on areas such as: people, the planet, prosperity, peace and alliances. This political articulation was developed during the National Agreement Forum (FAN) and it was complemented by the beginning of the Strategic Plan for National Development (PEDN) at the Government Center level, and the agriculture sector prospective document for 2030, at the Goal 2.4 level. These actions aim to generate favorable conditions for the Agenda implementation.

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
