### **Effects of COVID-19 in Bulgaria**

Decrease in gross domestic product (GDP) of 4,2% compared to the previous year

Reduction in tourist flows and international traffic and malfunctions in the economy

Decline in industrial production

Decreased employment rate in fourth quarter of 2020 by 1,9% 4,7% increase in gross external debt at the end of December 2020, compared to the end of 2019

# Continuity of operation – how it became possible



Access to databases of the Ministry of Finance and to public data and registers of ministries and agencies, as well as to databases and platforms maintained by the executive

VPN access to the BNAO's internal portal, e-mail and the automated record keeping system











# Continuity of operation – how it became possible

#### Videoconferencing platforms allowed:

 remote meetings of the BNAO Board and its functioning councils, commissions and working groups



 discussions within the audit teams and between the audit teams and the responsibles for quality control



meetings with responsible officers from the audited organizations
